

Minutes Zachary Taylor Parkway Association Board of Directors Quarterly Meeting
Wednesday, March 12, 2003 at Grace Episcopal Church Fellowship Hall in West Feliciana Parish

President Toye Taylor at 11: 05 a.m, called meeting to order.
